Make sure you understand your job assignment and tasks, and don't be afraid to ask questions. Follow through with the goals you set for yourself. Work on your communication skills, including active listening. Always be respectful. Observe and reflect how people act in the workplace. Put your electronics away until the end of your shift each day. Ask your supervisor if he or she would be willing to provide you with a reference after the job is over. Thank them for the experience.
